About epilepsy

For more than 50 years Epilepsy Queensland has been delivering help and hope to people impacted by epilepsy. Each year almost 4000 calls are made to our epilepsy helpline and we deliver over 2000 education sessions.

We are the organisation that 3000 newly diagnosed Queenslanders rely on for information and support.

Epilepsy is the most common serious neurological condition in the world. Each week 280 Australians will be diagnosed and sadly 5 will die from epilepsy-related causes.

Up to 50% of people with epilepsy do not know the cause and 30% of people will not gain seizure control with medication.
